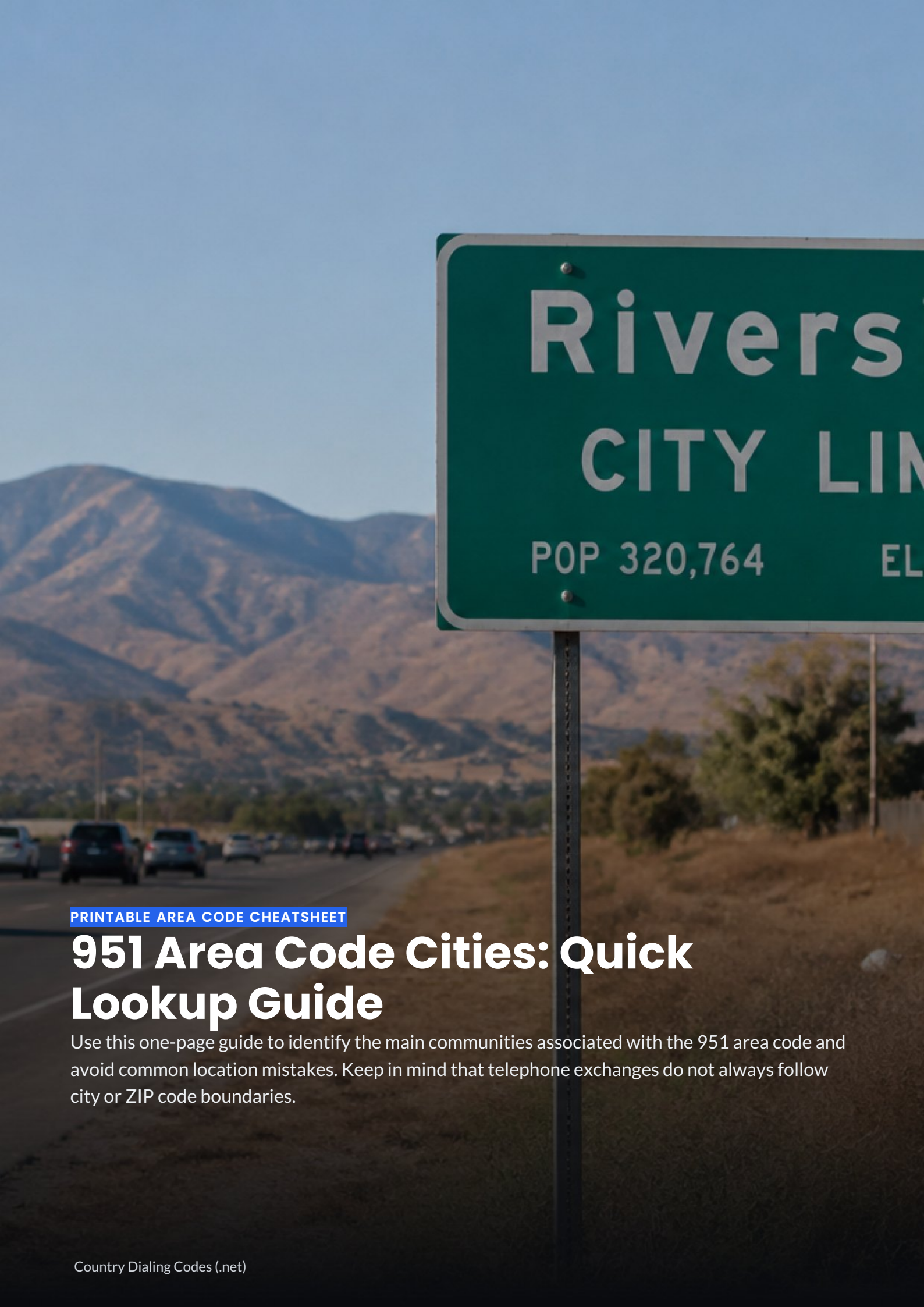




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PRINTABLE AREA CODE CHEATSHEET

951 Area Code Cities: Quick Lookup Guide

Use this one-page guide to identify the main communities associated with the 951 area code and avoid common location mistakes. Keep in mind that telephone exchanges do not always follow city or ZIP code boundaries.

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At a Glance

Primary region: Western and central Riverside County in California's Inland Empire.

Domestic dialing: Use the complete 10-digit number, including the 951 area code.

A 951 number is geographic, but the subscriber's current address still requires separate verification.

Time zone: Pacific Time, including standard and daylight-saving time.

Service history: Area code 951 entered service on July 17, 2004, after a split from area code 909.

Main 951 Area Code Cities by Corridor

Regional corridor	Associated cities and communities
Western corridor	Corona, Norco, Eastvale, Jurupa Valley and Riverside
Central valley	Moreno Valley, Perris, Hemet and San Jacinto
Southwestern corridor	Lake Elsinore, Menifee, Murrieta, Temecula and Wildomar
Inland and foothill corridor	Beaumont, Banning and Calimesa, along with nearby communities

Smaller Communities to Recognize

The wider 951 service region is also associated with Aguanga, Anza, Cabazon, French Valley, Nuevo, Winchester and Woodcrest. These names can help with a first lookup, but they should not be treated as a complete list of every telephone exchange, prefix or assigned number block.

Before You Rely on a 951 Number

- Confirm the complete telephone number**
Do not rely on the area code alone when the exact location matters.
- Separate city, ZIP code and exchange information**
These geographic boundaries can differ.
- Check the subscriber's current address separately**
A number may retain its original 951 prefix after a move or carrier change.
- Use 10-digit dialing for domestic calls**
Dial 951 plus the seven-digit local number.
- Consider neighboring area codes**
Nearby parts of Southern California may use 760, 442, 909, 714 or 949.

! Boundary Reminder

A city name is not proof that every number in that city belongs to the same 951 exchange. Telephone numbering areas follow exchanges and rate centres rather than clean municipal lines, so verify the exact number whenever precision matters.

This guide is a regional reference, not proof of a subscriber's current location or exact telephone exchange.
