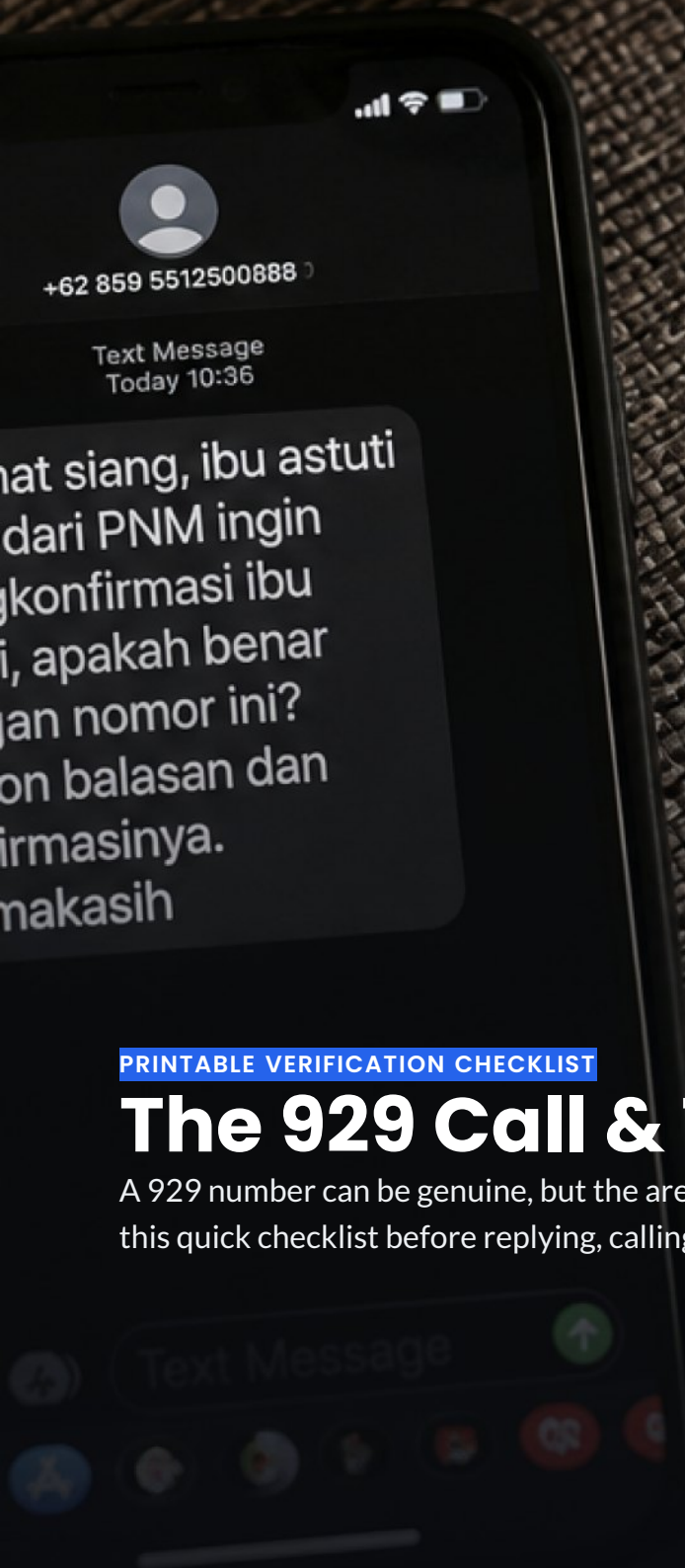

The 929 Call & Text Safety Check

A 929 number can be genuine, but the area code alone cannot prove who is contacting you. Use this quick checklist before replying, calling back, sharing information, or making a payment.

What the 929 area code tells you

929 is a legitimate New York area code associated with New York City and nearby communities.

Published references commonly associate 929 with Eastern Time.

It is used across the broad numbering territory that also includes 718, 347, 917, and 465.

A 929 caller ID shows only the number presented to your phone—not the caller's identity or physical location.

Serving New York City and Nearby Communities



WHAT IS AN OVERLAY?

An overlay adds a new area code to the same geographic region as existing area codes. All current phone numbers remain the same, and new numbers are assigned using the new area code.



INTRODUCTION DATE

APRIL 16, 2011

The 929 area code was introduced as an overlay to meet the growing demand for new phone numbers in the New York City area.



TIME ZONE

EASTERN TIME (ET)

All 929 numbers observe Eastern Time.

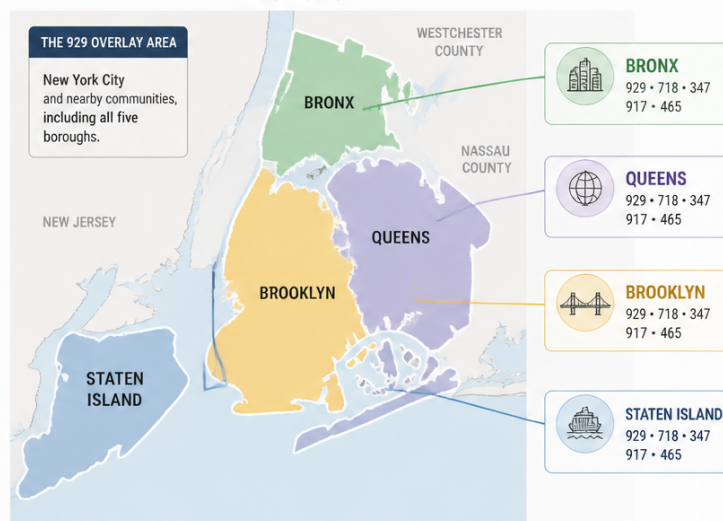


IMPORTANT TO KNOW

- 10-digit dialing is required for all calls within the overlay area (area code + phone number).
- Existing numbers with area codes 718, 347, 917, and 465 remain unchanged.
- New numbers in the same region may be assigned the 929 area code.

WHERE DOES 929 SERVE?

The 929 area code overlays the same geographic area as 718, 347, 917, and 465.



AREA CODES IN THE OVERLAY

929

Introduced April 16, 2011
New overlay area code for the NYC area.

718

Original area code
Established in 1947
Served NYC's outer boroughs.

347

Introduced in 1999
Added to help meet increasing demand.

917

Introduced in 1996
Originally for mobile and pager services in NYC.

465

Introduced in 2010
Newest addition before 929 to serve the same region.



ONE REGION. FIVE AREA CODES.

The 929 area code is one of multiple area codes that serve New York City and nearby communities. No matter which area code you see, it's the same great place to live, work, and connect.

! Treat the contact as unverified

A local-looking number may belong to a genuine person, business, temporary phone service, or scammer. Caller ID can be spoofed, transferred, or routed through internet calling services.

Before responding to an unexpected 929 call or text

Let an unexpected call go to voicemail

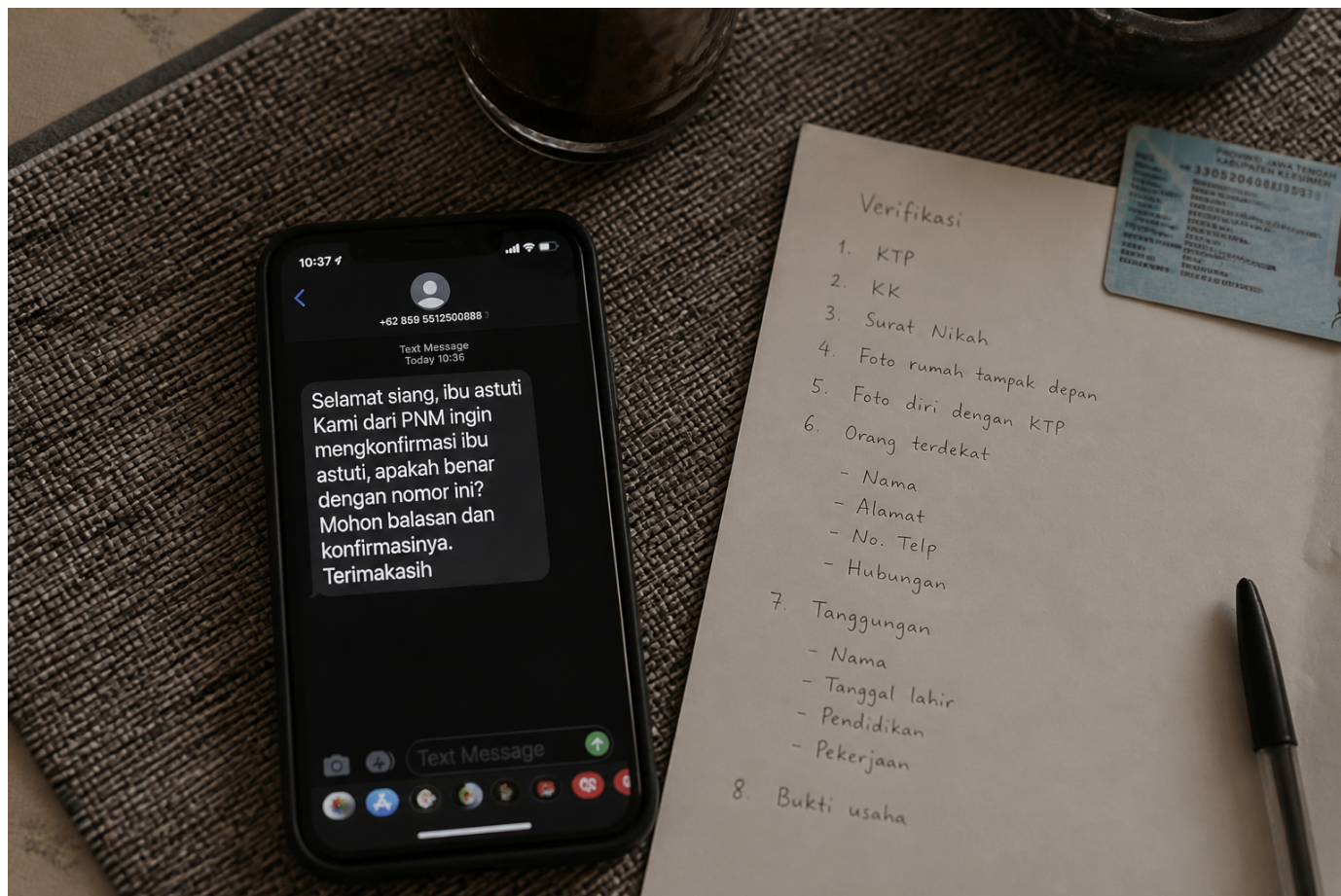
Review the message before deciding whether a response is necessary.

- Identify what the sender is asking for**
Be cautious when the request involves money, account access, identity documents, remote access, or a one-time code.
- Check for pressure or secrecy**
Immediate payment demands or instructions to keep the conversation secret are warning signs.
- Do not rely on the displayed name, logo, or signature**
These details add context but do not independently prove the sender's identity.
- Do not share sensitive information while the sender is unverified**
Never provide passwords, one-time codes, banking details, or payment information before verification.

Verify the sender safely



- 1 Pause**
Do not call back, reply, pay, or follow the sender's instructions simply because the number looks local.
- 2 Record the claim**
Note the caller's name, organization, department, and any reference number they provide.
- 3 Find an independent contact channel**
Use an official website, app, statement, or known phone number—not contact details supplied by the caller or included in the unexpected message.
- 4 Confirm the story**
Ask the organization through that trusted channel whether the contact and request are genuine.
- 5 Stop if verification fails**
If you cannot independently confirm the identity or request, do not provide information or send money.



VERIFICATION CHECKLIST Use an independent channel to check an unexpected 929 text before responding.

If the contact appears fraudulent

Keep the distinction clear: 929 is a legitimate area code, but an unknown caller or texter using 929 remains unverified until the claim checks out. Suspicious fraud can be reported to the FTC at [ReportFraud.ftc.gov](https://www.ftc.gov/report-fraud).

The 929 area code is legitimate; the caller or message still requires independent verification.
