Alice Mail Ownership: A Clear 3-Layer Guide

Use this one-page guide to separate the company, service name, and email domain behind Alice Mail. The short answer: Alice Mail belongs to the TIM corporate and service family, while @alice.it remains a legacy address identity.

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The answer at a glance

TIM S.p.A. is the current company associated with Alice Mail and the former Telecom Italia business.

alice.it is the historic email domain that may still appear in existing addresses.

An existing @alice.it address does not automatically become a different address just because TIM branding is used for access or support.

TIM Mail is the current TIM-branded email service identity.

Telecom Italia is the former corporate name that users may still see in older references.

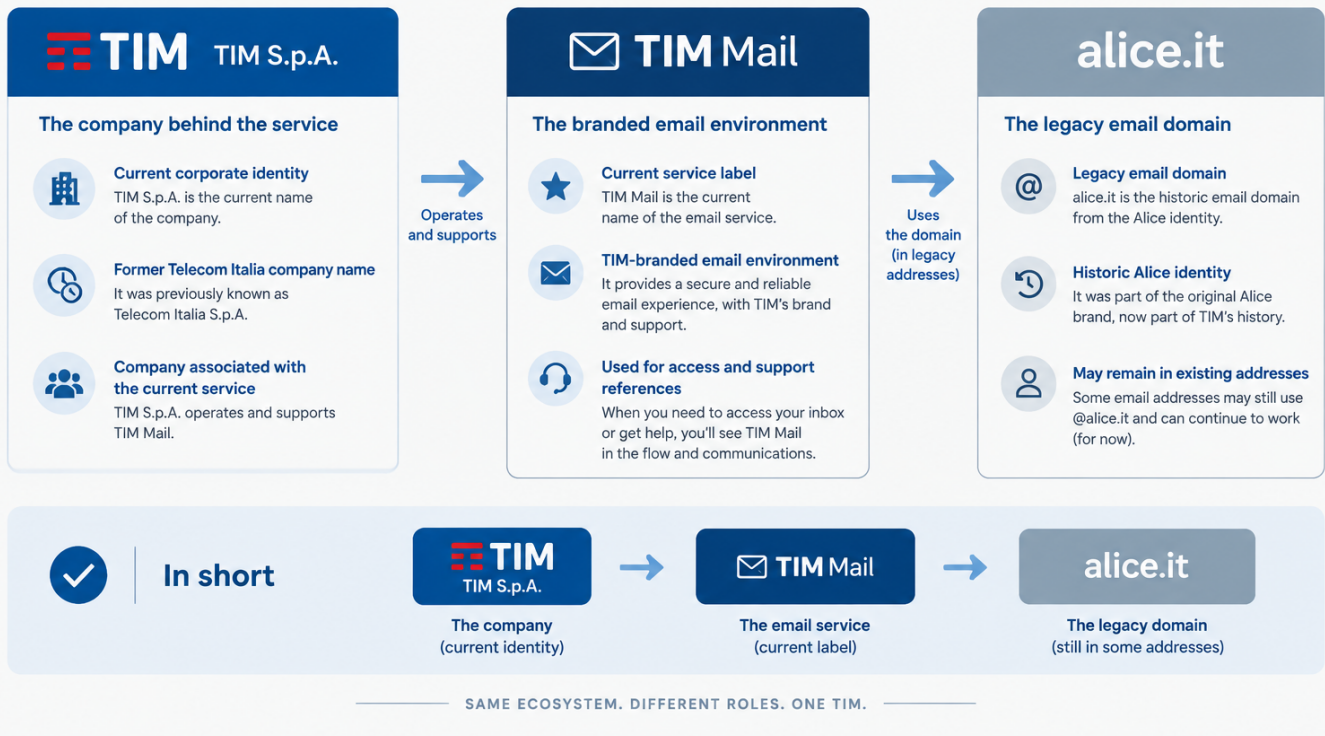
Company, service, and domain: what each name means

Name	What it represents	What you may see
TIM S.p.A.	The current corporate identity associated with the former Telecom Italia business.	Current company and service references.
TIM Mail	The current TIM-branded email service identity.	Login, support, and service pages.
alice.it	The historic email domain linked to the Alice identity.	Existing addresses ending in @alice.it.
Telecom Italia	The former company name behind the earlier consumer Alice internet service.	Older websites, account references, and support discussions.

How TIM S.p.A., TIM Mail and alice.it are Connected

One company. One email service. A legacy domain.

TIM S.p.A. is the current company, TIM Mail is the branded email service, and alice.it is the historic domain that may still appear in existing email addresses.

How to interpret an Alice Mail account



1 Look at the email address

An address ending in @alice.it indicates the legacy Alice domain. It does not, by itself, indicate a separate company called Alice.it.

2 Identify the service branding

If the login or support page refers to TIM Mail, that is the current service label associated with the mailbox environment.

3 Separate the corporate history

References to Telecom Italia describe the former company name, while TIM S.p.A. is the current corporate identity.

4 **Verify account-specific information**

For current login, recovery, or mailbox questions, use official TIM support rather than relying only on third-party domain information.

Before changing or recovering your mailbox



Confirm whether your address ends in @alice.it

This identifies the legacy domain used by the account.



Check whether the access page uses TIM Mail branding

The service label may be newer than the address itself.



Keep the original email address unchanged in your records

A TIM-branded login does not automatically change an existing address.



Use official TIM support for recovery instructions

Current account procedures should be verified directly with TIM.



Treat domain records as technical clues only

They can help identify infrastructure but do not settle every legal ownership question.

i Why the names can look inconsistent

The company name, service label, and email domain belong to different layers of the same corporate history. That is why an old @alice.it address can coexist with TIM Mail branding and references to Telecom Italia.

For current account access, recovery, and support information, verify details through official TIM channels. This guide distinguishes historical names, service branding, and domain identity; it is not a legal ownership opinion.
